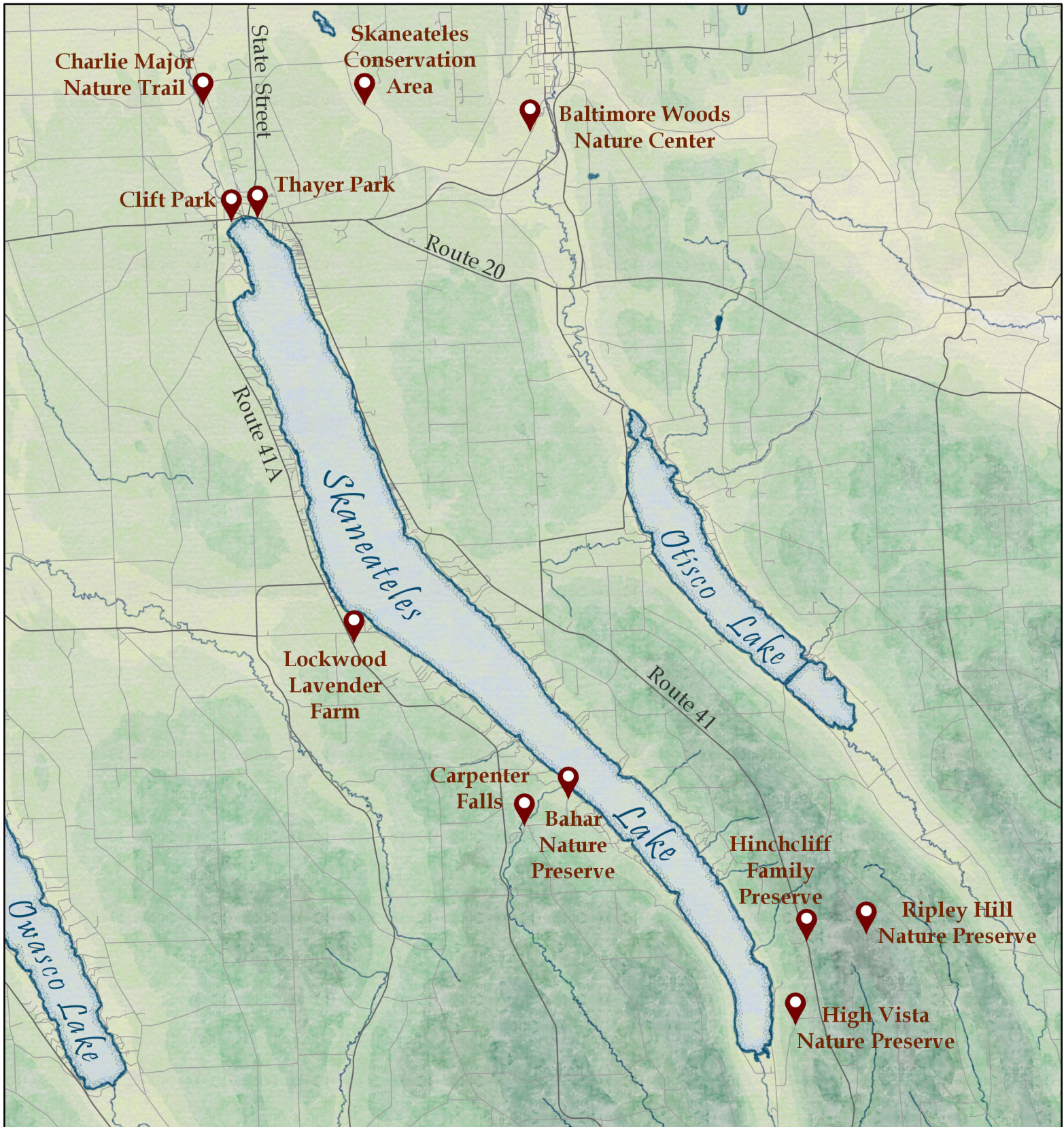

Directions from the Barrow Art Gallery:

1. Charlie Major Nature Trail - Head west on East Genesee St. and turn right onto Jordan St. After about 1.5 miles, turn left onto Oneill Ln., destination will be on the left.

2. Skaneateles Conservation Area - Head west on East Genesee St. and turn right onto Jordan St. After about 1.5 miles, turn right onto Old Seneca Turnpike. Drive 2.5 miles and turn right onto Gully Rd. There are multiple parking areas on Gully Rd. or you can continue on Old Seneca Turnpike to the main parking area for the upper section, which includes a pond and observation deck.

3. Baltimore Woods Nature Center ~ 4007 Bishop Hill Rd. - Head east on East Genesee St. and merge with Route 20 East. Follow Route 20 for approx. 2 miles, turn left onto Route 175 East. After about 2.5 miles, turn left onto Bishop Hill Rd. and go 1 more mile. gofingerlakes.org/baltimore

4. Clift Park - Head west on East Genesee St. for 1/4 mile, destination will be on the left.

5. Thayer Park - Head east on East Genesee St., destination will be on the right.

6. Lockwood Lavender Farm ~ 1682 West Lake Road - Head west on East Genesee St. for 1/2 mile then turn left onto Route 41A South. Follow 41A for 6.8 miles; the farm will be on the left.

7. Carpenter Falls Unique Area - Head west on East Genesee St. for 1/2 mile, turn left onto Route 41A South. Follow 41A for 11 miles and turn left on Appletree Point Rd. The parking area will be on the left. Follow trail upstream to falls overlook. gofingerlakes.org/carpenter

8. Bahar Nature Preserve - Head west on East Genesee St. for 1/2 mile then turn left onto Route 41A South. Follow 41A for 11 miles and turn left on Appletree Point Road. At the intersection of Appletree Point Rd. and Plunkie Point Rd., bear left onto Appletree Point Rd.. Proceed 1/4 mile to parking area on the left where a trail leads to the lake. flt.org/bahar

9. Hinchcliff Family Preserve - Head east on East Genesee St. After 1/2 mile, turn right onto Route 41 South. Drive about 14 miles to the intersection with Covey Rd. Turn right on Covey Rd. and follow to the end.

10. Ripley Hill Nature Preserve - Head east on East Genesee St. for 1/2 mile then turn right onto Route 41 South. Follow Route 41 for about 13 miles. Turn left onto Cold Brook Rd. and then take the first right onto Ripley Hill Rd. Follow Ripley Hill Rd. south for approximately 1.5 miles to a hilltop meadow. Although there are no hiking trails at Ripley Hill, the meadow can be painted from the unpaved road.

11. High Vista Nature Preserve - Head east on East Genesee St. for 1/2 mile then turn right onto Route 41 South. Follow Route 41 for about 15 miles and turn right on Vincent Hill Rd. at the Onondaga/Cortland County line. The parking area is on the right at a deep bend in the road. Walk down the road to find the preserve entrance on the left. flt.org/highvista
