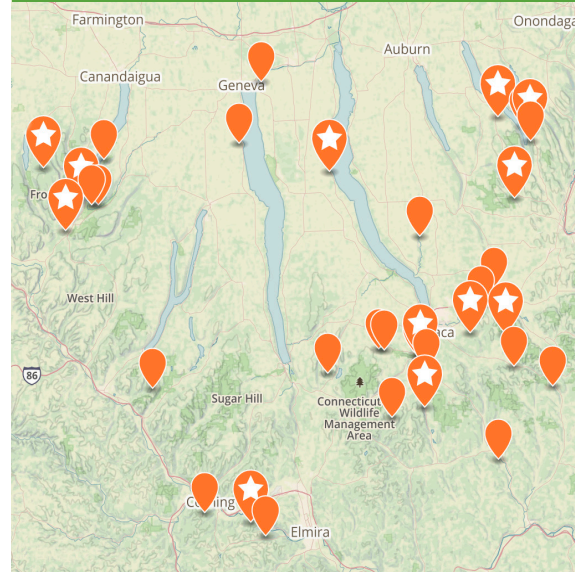

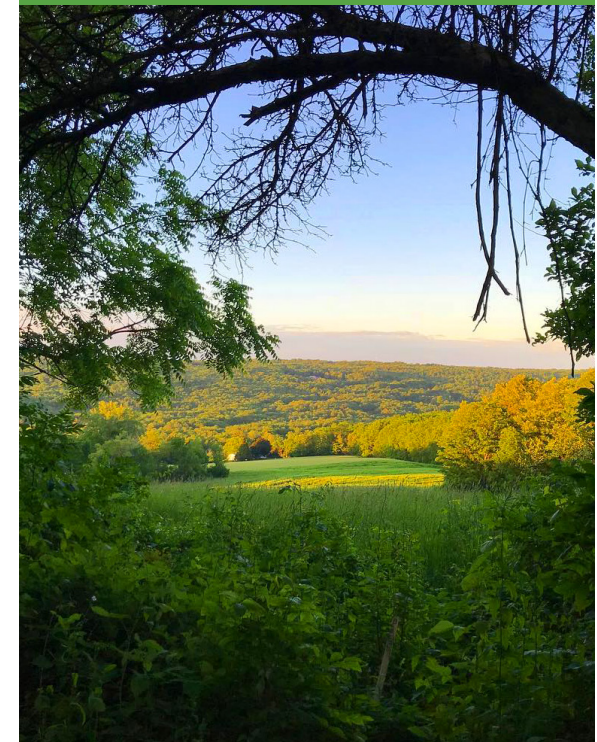

 **County:** Tompkins

A highlight of the 585-mile Finger Lakes Trail, this wooded preserve in Enfield, just west of Ithaca, offers ideal options for an easy walk or connection to a much longer, more challenging hike.

## NATURAL HISTORY

Owned by the Finger Lakes Trail Conference subject to a conservation easement held by the Finger Lakes Land Trust, the Bock-Harvey Forest Preserve features some of our region's oldest, most majestic sugar maples – including the preserve's tallest ones thought to be 300 years old. The main trail leads through a grove and a large meadow rife with goldenrod and other wildflowers, and continues into the forest.

## HISTORY

Throughout centuries of ownership, the Bock and Harvey families faithfully protected their land. In 2012, the Bock family approached the Land Trust about donating their land and ensuring its protection. Recognizing the importance of the property to hikers, the Land Trust engaged the Trail Conference and the Cayuga Trails Club in a partnership.
